Appendix 1

1870s

17-04-1870 family came to West End to live.

In March 1877 the bay window was put in Alma Villa (No.3)

May 1878 the tapestry carpet was got for parlour and large bedroom glass for first bedroom

March 1879 the range was put in

1880

No. 1

April 1880 the gable was slated and whole house painted

No. 3

May 1880 tapestry carpet and plated teapot

10 small plated forks 6 large

6 dinner knives and 6 small ones

Large carving knife and fork

2 white quilts and bedroom glass

2 pairs of blankets

1881

In April 1881 the ale store house was rebuilt and the shop front raised

1881 we got Paddock fields from Col. Mc Donnell

No.1

In May he got drawing room chairs 14 shillings each.

1882

Shop

April 1882 entablature heightened and china letters up

Sept. 1882 he bought a mangle. It cost £2 15 shillings including carriage

1883

24-04-1883 he bought trap and silver mouth harness

1884

April 1884 shop lengthened and all papered and painted No. 1 and 3

1885

March 1885 he bought No.5 from Mrs. Capt. Fitzgerald

May 1885 he got the parlour chairs at Cannocks for 10 shillings each.

Drawing room carpet, 3 wash stands, little brass kettle, new hall tarpaulin

New iron bedstead own room

December: stove for the shops

1886

range no.3
April roofing and slating store

1887

Shed in No.1 pit repaired

No. 4 yard a new closet
Painting the shop

Bought mattress, marble washstand and table at auction in Limerick

Sofa and chairs covered in no.3

November, Nos. 3 and 4 slated, addition to No.4 of 2 rooms.

1888

He bought cottage piano and mahogany chest of drawers from Mr. Eaton
No.1 house newly slated in March to June, addition of 3 bedrooms built and W.C.
Bought cabinet at McCarthy's auction and bought at Henry Keane's auction wardrobe, cabinet, sofa
and bed stands, 3 pairs new blankets, 3 quilts and chest of drawers

1889

Bay window put in Nos. 3, 4 and 5 and No.2 slated.
Studdert Auction, bought wardrobe with glass door.

1890

Built an addition to No. 3. Put in second bay window

No.4 bought iron chair bed, also ottoman bed, chairs at Capt. Fitzgerald's auction basket chair,
washstand wares, towel horse and iron bedstead

Bought Circular Road house October 1890.

1891

Painted ale house inside and out bought drawing room chairs no.3 and other things at auction, linen
press, garden chairs nos. 4 and 5

1892

Got donkey and water carts

New range in No.4.
Altered rooms in No. 5 small sitting room
Got cabinet No. 5 at auction also 6 chairs
Garden chair no.3
New tarpaulin on counter, 2 sets of lace curtains
Little sweet scales and brass weights

1893

Put up hall in No.5, slated back, papered 2 bedrooms,
no.3 papered and painted put up shed in store May.

Large brass scales in July.

1894

February put up ceiling in shop and reslated roof.

Put in bay window in No.5 bedroom, bought carpet for 2 small bedrooms

New pair blankets no.3

Got donkey trap and brown harness Dec. 1894

1895

Addition of kitchen, breakfast room and bedroom to no.4

No. 4 the addition built finished in June

Drawing room carpet no.1

Put in bay window no.2 papered and painted it, new range in kitchen.

10th March got 3 new looking glasses and 3 pairs of blankets, upholstered chairs no. 5 and chair no. 3

Got silver stand

Got Iceland ponies July

Tarpaulin No.1 stairs

1896

May: built little house Circular Road, had Mr. O'Donoghue paint

Tarpaulin on No.3 sitting room

Rent from Mrs. Smith for June £6 and for July was £8.

Rent for August from Mrs Palmer £12.

Rent for Sept. from Mrs. Massy Westropp £6 10 shillings.

1897

Slated back no.3 built scullery

Bought at auction looking glass no.5, chest drawers no.4, marble wash stand pictures

Got new harness and got trap done up.

1898

No. 2 rebuilt finished in June (see details of cost in appendix 2)
